

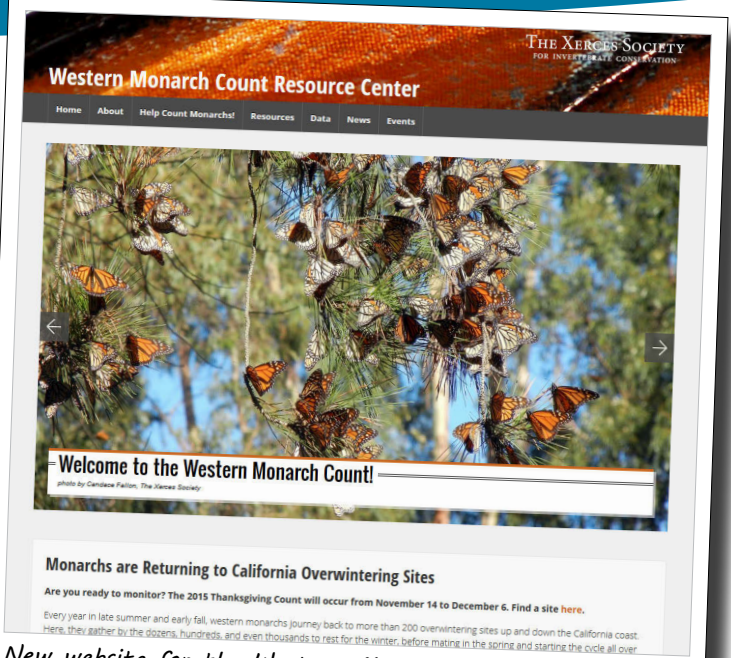

Surveying for rare butterflies takes staff to some lovely spots!



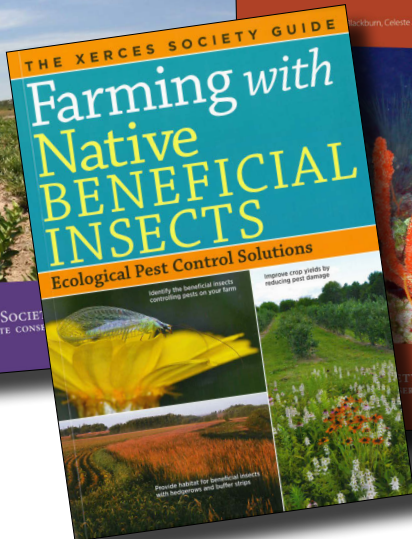
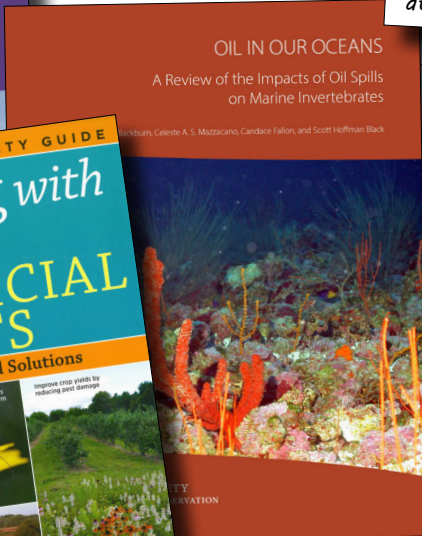
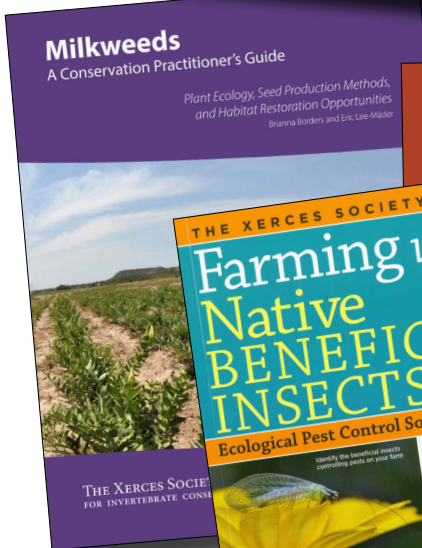

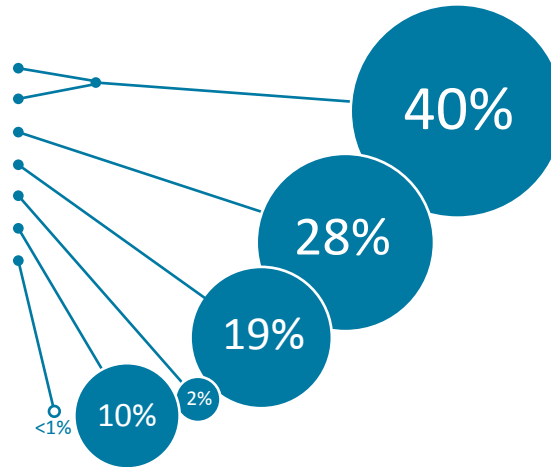
Pollinator habitat blooming in spring 2014

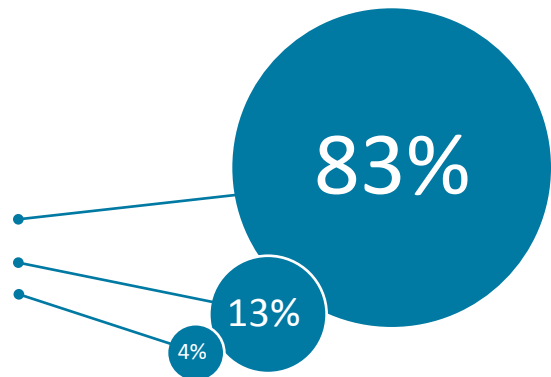
